

Course Welcome Instructions

Thank you for booking a course with Wyatt First Aid. Due to the ongoing situation with the COVID-19 pandemic we have all had to adjust the way we live and work. Your welfare is important to us, so we have carried out a risk assessment and put in place measures to help keep you safe while you train. In fact, we all need to **work together to keep each other safe***. With that in mind we are keeping you informed before your course so you can arrive confident and relaxed. Things may be a little different but please be assured of a friendly welcome as always!

Before the course:

- We will contact you by telephone before the course start day to carry out a COVID-19 screening assessment and answer any questions you may have.
- About 1 in 3 people with COVID-19 do not have symptoms but can still infect others. We request that all learners do a 'Rapid Lateral Flow Test' within 48 hours of the course start. Tests are free and give you a result in 30 minutes. Collect a test kit pack from a pharmacy or order online at www.gov.uk. Trainers will only attend the course if they have a negative test result.
- Please ensure you have a **black pen** and a note pad for your own use. A black pen is essential for completing the multiple-choice question paper.
- Please bring your own lunch and drink to consume throughout the day. There will be no catering provided unless this is available at your workplace.
- Please bring your own **face mask** to wear on entry of the training room and during the course.
- Please bring disposable tissues and alcohol hand sanitiser for your own use.

Arrival at the course:

- All learners will be screened prior to entry of the training room. Please wear a face mask. Observe social distancing of 2 metres if there is another learner waiting in front of you.
- We will re-ask you the questions from the COVID-19 screening assessment.
- Please be aware that in addition to our Data Protection Policy, your contact information will be held securely for the purposes of the NHS Test & Trace service.

- We will ask if we may take your temperature using a touch-free forehead thermometer. We will be wearing PPE and ask you wear a face mask.
- You will be asked to sanitise your hands and sign in.
- You will be issued with an individual training pack and allocated a personal training area which is socially distanced 2 metres away from the trainer and other learners.

During the course:

- It is everyone's responsibility to keep each other safe.
- Social distancing of 2 metres will be in place throughout the duration of the course.
- Do not touch your mouth, nose or eyes unless you have just washed your hands.
- Hand sanitiser will be provided in the training room for your use.
- At the end of every theory session you will be asked to wash or sanitise your hands.
- Before and after each practical session you will be asked to wash or sanitise your hands.
- All trainers and learners are required to wear a face mask.
- Each learner will have clean or single use equipment for use when training. We will teach you adaptations to keep safe during the COVID-19 pandemic. Learner demonstration of rescue breaths with CPR has been temporarily suspended.
- We will ask you to demonstrate your skills for assessment on your manikin, yourself or using PPE if the 2 metre zone is breached.
- We will work closely with your workplace or the venue owners to provide you with a safe environment to train in. This includes cleaning of frequently touched points at each break, social distancing, hand hygiene measures and respiratory hygiene (coughing into a tissue or bent elbow then sanitising hands). The training space will be well ventilated, therefore please bring multiple layers of clothing to ensure you are warm enough.
